A faculty has been granted for the installation of a ring of ten bells with a tenor weight just under 17 cwt. The Keltek Trust is supporting the project by donating the back four bells of the proposed ring. They were cast by Taylor's in 1916 and originally installed as part of an eight-bell chime at St Mary, Low Harrogate, North Yorkshire.
