### Christchurch, NZ, Transitional Cathedral



The largest single donation to date made by the Keltek Trust is eight bells for the proposed ring of eight to be installed in a purpose-built structure next to the Transitional Cathedral.

The Thames Diamond Jubilee Pageant Committee have donated the Royal Jubilee Bell Tower to the project. Currently the design of the structure is at the preliminary stage and requires Planning approval. Once finalised the Royal Jubilee Bell tower metalwork will be adapted accordingly.

Current plans indicate it will be 10 years before bells will ring out again at the original Cathedral.
