Beaudesert, Warwickshire, St Nicholas



The unringable ring of three bells was restored and augmented to six during 2013. The existing bells were not well in tune and two were listed for preservation by the Church Buildings Council. One of the listed bells has been retired and four bells added to create the new ring; the treble bell was located by the Keltek Trust and we donated the 2nd of the ring of six; this bell came from St Luke, Barrow-in-Furness.

Kineton, Warwickshire, St Peter



The pre-2008 treble was heavier than the 2nd, 3rd and 4th bells of the ring. A decision was taken to replace it when the ring was augmented to eight and it has now been installed at nearby Charwelton, Northamptonshire as the treble of the augmentation to five.

Leek Wootton, Warwickshire, All Saints



The work to augment the ring of five bells to six was completed during June 2015. At the same time the poor toned tenor bell was replaced by a second-hand bell ex-Great St Mary, Cambridge. It had previously been acquired for use at Woolpit, Suffolk but subsequently re-sold by the parish to Leek Wootton.

The unringable ring of three bells has been restored and augmented to five. The 2nd of five is from Adlestrop, Gloucestershire and the treble is a newly cast surplus bell donated by the Keltek Trust.

The five bells were rung for the first time on 13th December 2017.
