The two tenor bells of the ring were replaced in 2003 by newly cast bells. The displaced bells are now hung as part of the chime at Ennis Cathedral, Ireland.

High Wycombe, Buckinghamshire, All Saints



The ring of twelve bells was replaced during 2012 and the Trust assisted with the relocation of several bells. Two bells have been installed at Horton-in-Ribblesdale, North Yorkshire to augment the ring of four to six. One bell has been installed at St Mary, Kilburn, Greater London as part of an ambitious project to hang the chime of three for full circle ringing with the addition of three bells to create a ring of six. One bell has been installed at Bicknoller, Somerset to augment the ring to six and one bell has been installed for chiming at the former church of St Michael, Gloucester.

Lathbury, Buckinghamshire, All Saints



Subject to faculty and fund-raising it is hoped to restore the unringable ring of five bells and augment to a ring of six. The proposed treble bell was the pre-2017 4th bell at Cheltenham Minster.

Subject to faculty and fundraising it is planned to restore and augment the unringable five at Slapton to a ring of six. The Trust is donating a bell to replace the existing 2nd and a bell suitable as the treble of six. These were part of the pre-2016 eight at St Michael's church, Kirkham, Lancashire.
