
The ring of six bells has been augmented to twelve by adding newly cast bells. A service bell located by the Trust has been installed; it is a bell cast by Reignold Churche in the 15th Century and has been on the floor of St Helen's church Ipswich for over 90 years.


A light ring of eight bells was installed during 2017. The Keltek Trust providing the tenor bell, a former Trinity House buoy bell.
