#### Barbon, Cumbria, St Bartholomew



Barbon is the second church where an ex-Trinity House buoy has been installed as part of a ringing peal of bells. The ring of four were augmented to six during 2003 by the addition of a newly cast treble bell and an ex-TH buoy bell cast by Taylor's in 1964.
