A light ring of eight bells has been installed at St. Mary's church. The back six were originally a chime from Christ Church, Llanelli. The Keltek Trust donated three of these bells to the project.

The ring of bells were officially opened on 9th September 2017.



Kilmood, Co. Down, Ireland, St Mary



A light ring of six bells has been installed at St Mary's church to commemorate the centenary of the end of the Great War. The Keltek Trust & Trinity House have each offered to donate a bell to the project. The Trinity House bell is the tenor and the Keltek Trust bell the 3rd of the ring of bells.

Limerick, Co. Limerick, Ireland, Cathedral church of St John



During 2002 the Trust located three bells for a chime at the Cathedral. One bell came from Hawkhurst, Kent, one from Manchester and the third was acquired by auction at Sotheby's. In 2005 we provided a small Irish-cast bell for use as a service bell.

The Trust acquired a modern True Harmonic bell from Great St Mary, Cambridge and it has now been installed at the Cathedral to augment the ring of five to six.
