Ab Kettleby, Leicestershire, St James



The church closed in 2006 because of structural problems but the local villagers raised over £250,000 to repair the church. It reopened during 2013 and has been the recipient of an English Heritage Angel award to mark the achievement of saving the historic building.

The minor-key ring of three has been augmented to six by adding two newly cast treble bells and a tenor bell ex-Gorran, Cornwall. The work was completed during January 2016.

The parish acquired a modern Taylor bell from the pre-2004 ring at Kettering, Northamptonshire to replace the existing seventh bell.

Harby, Leicestershire, St Mary the Virgin

The unringable ring of four bells was restored shortly after the millennium. A fifth bell was added during 2006 and a sixth bell located by the Trust was installed in October 2007.

The ring of three was replaced in 2008 by a ring of six incorporating one of the original three bells. In 2010 the 3rd bell cracked and in 2011 it was replaced by a bell donated by the Keltek Trust.

Sibson, Leicestershire, St Botolph



The ring of four bells was augmented to six during 2007 by adding two second-hand bells. The treble of six was the former 4th bell from the pre-millennium ring at Kettering, Northamptonshire and was donated by the Keltek Trust.

Sutton Cheney, Leicestershire, St James



The recently restored ring of four bells has been augmented to six by adding two second-hand bells. The second of six was located by Matthew Higby & George Dawson. The treble of six is an undated 20th Century Taylor bell acquired from a scrapyard in Warrington and has been donated to the church by the Keltek Trust.

Thornton, Leicestershire, St Peter




The ring of three was augmented to a ring of six bells during December 2019 by adding two surplus bells and a newly cast treble. The second of six is the former tenor bell of the unringable ring of three removed from the redundant church of St Mary, Foxholes, N. Yorkshire. The 3rd bell is the former 5th from the ring of eight at St Paul, Widnes removed in the 1980's and the treble bell is a newly cast bell in memory of John M Jelley who left a substantial legacy to the Keltek Trust.

Thorpe Arnold, Leicestershire, St Mary the Virgin



The ring of three bells was augmented to five during 2003 with the addition of two surplus bells. The Trust located one of these, the second of the ring of five, from a scrap metal dealer in Burton-on-Trent. It appears the bell was cast as a clock bell and installed at a private house in Staffordshire before being removed and sold for scrap.



Tilton-on-the-Hill, Leicestershire, St Peter



During March 2004 the ring of four bells was augmented to five with the addition of the old 5th bell from Whetstone. A newly cast treble was added during September 2014 to complete the ring of six.



Whetstone, Leicestershire, St Peter



The pre-2002 ring had a weak, under-sized and under-weight tenor. This bell was replaced by a modern Taylor bell acquired from a redundant church in Patna, Scotland. The fifth bell was replaced at the same time with a newly cast bell.
