A ring of ten bells with a tenor weight just under 17 cwt has been installed and individual bells were rung for the first time during January 2021. The Kelttek Trust supported the project by donating the back four bells of the ring. They were cast by Taylor's in 1916 and originally installed as part of an eight-bell chime at St Mary, Low Harrogate, North Yorkshire. The six treble bells are all newly cast bells.
