

The priory church has a fine ring of eight bells cast by John Warner & Sons of Cripplegate, London. The Trust was involved with their acquisition from Dunecht House, Grampian where they were hung as a chime.

St Andrews, Fife, St Salvator's Chapel



The ring of two bells at St Salvator's Chapel, St Andrews has been augmented to a ring of six. The Trust supplied three redundant bells and donated one of these to the project. Two bells came from the redundant church of St George's North, Greenock and one bell from Cradley Heath Methodist church.

Tulloch, Highland, The Ringing Centre



A ring of twelve bells has been installed at the Tulloch Ringing Centre in Scotland. The tenor weight is 7cwt and the back six have been formed from the former Gillett & Johnston chimes at Quarriers Village and St George's North, Greenock. Four bells came from Greenock and two from Quarriers Village.

A light ring of eight bells with a tenor weight of 1-1-15 was installed during July 2015 in a purpose built tower. The two tenor bells came from the former chime at Christ Church, Prestatyn, the 3rd from St Ethelburga, St Leonards on Sea.
