

Allesley, West Midlands, All Saints



The Trust acquired the old 3rd bell when it was replaced by a newly cast bell in 2011. The bell was installed at Little Bedwyn, Wiltshire during May 2014 as part of the restoration scheme and is the treble of the ring of five. During 2014 the Trust acquired a bell ex-Holy Trinity, Bury which has replaced the 6th bell of the ring of eight at Allesley.

Birmingham, West Midlands, St Anne, Moseley



The Trust located and donated a second-hand bell ex-Grimsby, All Saints to augment the chime of five to six bells and they were re-hung for full-circle ringing during 2008. There are plans to improve the ring by replacing the front three bells with heavier modern True Harmonic tuned bells. The Keltek Trust has offered to donate two replacement treble bells, both of which are modern Taylor bells cast in 1985.

Birmingham, West Midlands, St Mary, Moseley



The existing ring of steel bells has been replaced with a bronze ring incorporating three tenor bells from the redundant St George's North church, Greenock. This formed the basis of a ring of ten bells with a tenor weight of 18-0-9.



The photograph was taken on 30th September 2012 at Taylor's Bellfoundry and show the ring of ten bells prior to installation. The three ex-Greenock bells are the three largest bells to the RHS of the picture.

Coseley, West Midlands, Christ Church

Subject to faculty and fund-raising it is proposed to install a light ring of eight bells at Christ Church for the training of recruits. The expected tenor weight is approximately 2.5cwt. The Keltek Trust is supporting the project by donating two bells and a set of ringing fittings.
